





Halloween Joke Teller

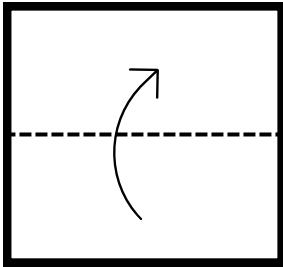

1. Print, Color and cut your Halloween Joke teller. Fold and you're ready with Halloween jokes to share.
2. Have the player choose one of the top four squares. The person with the joke teller spells out the name while opening and closing the joke teller for each letter.
3. Player selects a number. The person with the joke teller counts out loud while opening and closing the joke teller for each count (to the selected number).
4. Player selects a number. The person with the joke teller tells the joke under that number and opens the flap for the answer.
5. Player and the person with joke teller switch places and continue playing.

Instructions

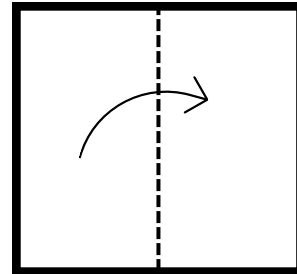
After cutting out the paper square follow the steps below.

1



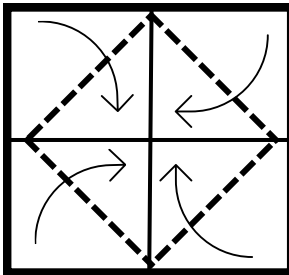
With the design facing up fold in half vertically. Unfold.

2



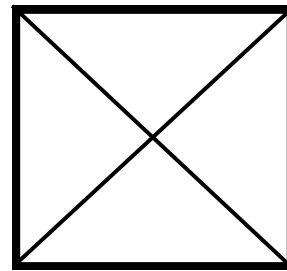
With design facing up fold in half horizontally.

3



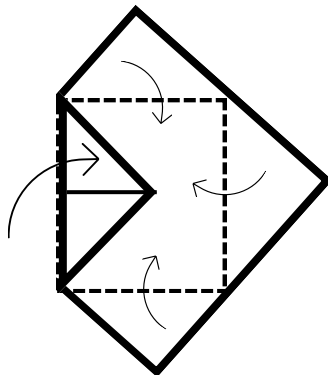
With the design facing down, fold each corner to the center.

4



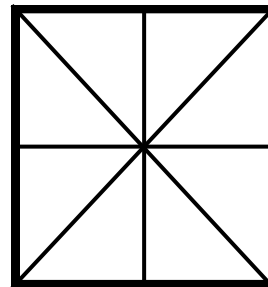
Flip paper over, the question part of the joke will be facing up.

5



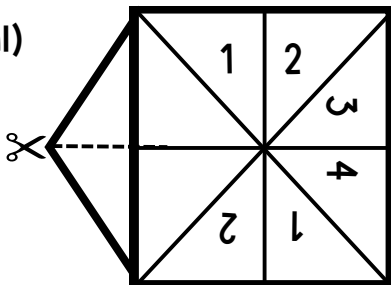
Fold each corner to the center.

6



Fold in half from top to bottom. crease along center line. Do not unfold.

8 (optional)



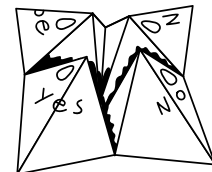
Cut between the numbers on each flap so you only lift one joke at a time.

Crease along center lines into a square with the words facing out.

10



Unfold to step 6. slide thumbs and forefingers under the squares with names and form the cootie catcher shape. Move the joke teller back and forth to play.
